Building the Workforce of the Future

We have kicked off a five-year community impact partnership with the Dr. Howard Fuller Collegiate Academy (HFCA), a tuition-free, non-profit public charter high school open to all students in Milwaukee, by announcing plans to donate our property at 4030 N. 29th Street in Milwaukee to the organization. Together, Goodwill and HFCA will engage students, their families, and the community in experiences that advance education, employment training and career pipeline opportunities. Our team members joined the Academy for their Back-to-School Block Party for enrolled students on August 24, 2022 participating in an Act of Goodwill by handing out backpacks, school supplies and other giveaways, and sharing employment opportunities and readiness workshops with parents and guardians. The partnership will support Milwaukee's future workforce and impact the families of HFCA scholars for generations to come.
