We created a plan with her Day Services Case Manager and MPS Home and Hospital Instruction Program in Milwaukee to support her path to graduation, providing technology, a safe and quiet place to work and support to complete assignments. Amaya successfully graduated from high school on a traditional education track in May 2022. Amaya says, “Goodwill helped me learn social skills and build friendships. They showed me activities like American Sign Language that help me communicate with people who are deaf and take me places and help me feel less isolated. I also enjoy Goodwill’s cooking classes where everyone gets a chance to learn and then cook at home too.”
